InSinkErator (ISE) Food Waste Disposer Care & Use Guide

How to Operate Your InSinkErator (ISE) Disposer

- 1. Remove the sink plug above the disposer unit.
- 2. Turn on the **cold water tap** to ensure strong water flow.
- 3. Switch on the disposer using the air switch or wall power switch.
- 4. Feed food scraps into the disposer gradually.
- 5. Let the **cold water run for 10–15 seconds** after grinding is complete to flush waste thoroughly through the plumbing.

Smart Usage Tips - DOs

- Always use **cold water** while operating.
- Grind natural food waste only.
- Dispose of vegetable peels, fruit pits, pasta, rice, meat scraps, coffee grounds, tea bags, eggshells, and similar items.
- V Flush the unit after each use with cold water.
- Operate the disposer regularly to keep it clean and prevent rust or residue.

Things to Avoid - DON'Ts

- X DO NOT use hot water while grinding.
- X DO NOT dispose of glass, feathers, string, or non-organic waste.
- X DO NOT grind oyster shells.
- X DO NOT pour grease, oils, fats, or chemicals into the disposer.
- X DO NOT turn off the unit or water flow until fully complete grinding.

Quick DIY Troubleshooting Tips

If your InSinkErator (ISE) isn't working correctly, try these steps before calling for service:

- 1. Power Off Ensure the unit is turned off and unplugged.
- 2. \tageq Clear Jams Use the included hex key to turn the bottom shaft back and forth manually.
- 3. Press Reset Find and press the red reset button on the bottom of the unit.
- 4. **Check Power Supply** Inspect your home's breaker panel for tripped circuits.
- 5. **Drain Check** Place a bucket under the trap, disassemble it, and remove any debris for slow drainage.
