

Water Damage Moisture Risk Checklist

Use this checklist to identify hidden risks before they escalate. It's a handy tool for spotting potential water damage issues before they become significant problems.

✓ Visual Clues That Moisture May Be Present:

- Some Musty odours, even if there is no visible mould
- Specifical Discolorization
 Discolorization
- Peeling paint or bubbling plaster
- Swarped wooden floors or skirting boards
- Section Cracked grout or lifting tiles in wet areas

✓ Key Areas to Inspect After a Leak or Flood:

- 🖶 Under kitchen & laundry cabinets
- Behind toilets, under vanities & basins
- Under or behind hot water systems
- Subfloor or crawlspace (if applicable)
- E Flooring near doors, balconies, or windows



• \rightleftharpoons Behind tiled walls where plumbing runs

- Widden mould growth
- Rotting structural timber
- Damp insulation retaining moisture
- Weakened wall integrity
- 🎄 Insurance claim rejection from non-licensed work

Documentation Tips (for Insurance Claims):

- Photograph visible damage immediately
- Record when the leak started and what action was taken
- Request a professional moisture assessment (AS-IICRC S500:2025-compliant)

↑ When to Call a Professional:

- X Persistent musty odours or stains
- X Rising water bills with no apparent cause
- X Water-damaged electrical fittings



• X Recurring damp patches in the exact location
